Therefore if the plants you wish to cut do not fall in the category of duck food plants or lotus it is unnecessary to have a permit to cut them. However, I wish to point out that if you do cut these weeds they must be collected and brought to shore for proper disposition. The public service commission holds that such weeds cut cannot be allowed to float in the water as a hindrance to navigation and to create a nuisance." SIA19271959-169
