Maintain healthy financials for the district and continue to be fiscally responsible to you, our neighbors & constituents.

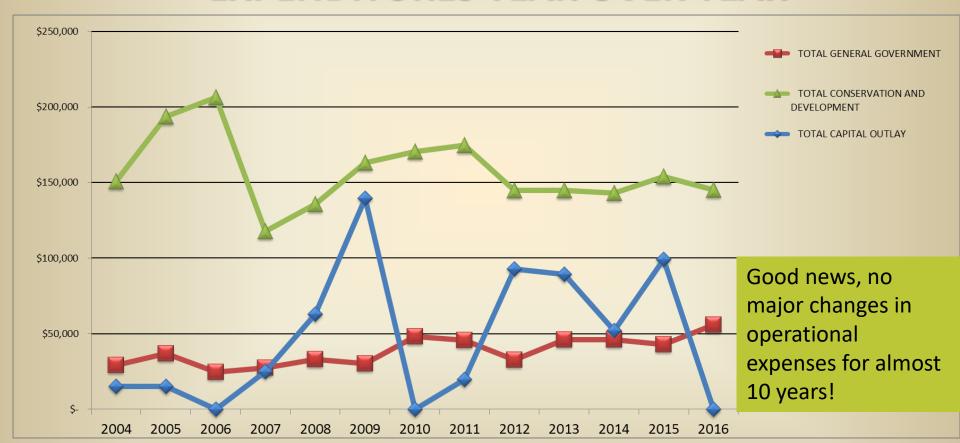

# Financial questions:

Why the tax revenue decrease?

- In 2016 CCLRD did not use all of the revenue taken in, mainly because we received the rest of the DNR grant money for the new cutter (about \$27K) which we could not plan for.
- CCLRD also held the line on expenses again for 2016, coming in below budgeted expenses and thus accruing about \$11K in unused income.
- CCLRD has taken the stance that we will not put unused revenue funds into a "slush" fund as is commonly done. We will be as transparent as possible and report the "slush" revenue and per state statutes, use that revenue in the following year budget plan.

So even though the 2018 CCLRD expenses are on par with prior years, we deducted about \$39K from the tax base revenue and applied the 2016 over revenue amount, resulting in a tax revenue reduction.
